Paint

Oil Painters- I will be using Cobra Water Soluble Oils. Please feel free to stick with regular oils, although I am moving away from solvents and encourage you to try water soluble for this workshop. **NOT required.**

You can get an inexpensive starter set on [amazon.com](https://www.amazon.com/Cobra-Mixable-Colour-Starter-5x40ml/dp/B004YDCGLK) <https://www.amazon.com/Cobra-Mixable-Colour-Starter-5x40ml/dp/B004YDCGLK>, or feel free to purchase my palette colors at Dick Blick, Jerry's Artarama, or your local art store if they carry Cobra.

Again, please feel free to use your regular oils.

Acrylic Painters- Any acrylics acceptable. My fav is Utrecht brand. Very buttery! Please feel free to use whatever you have though.

My Palette:

Ultramarine Blue	Cadmium Yellow Lemon (or Light)

*Primary Magenta	Titanium White

***Specific to the Cobras, any cool, pinkish color acceptable, such as Alizirin, Quinacrodone, etc.**

Brushes

I use a variety of **Flats, Rounds, and Filberts**, primarily: **#6, #8, #10**, and **Egberts** (long filberts), **#4 and #6**. My brand of choice is **Richeson**. You can find my **Anne Blair Brown Brush Set Kits (which come in both studio and plein air versions and include other goodies!)** at **Judson's Art Outfitters**: goo.gl/7Bk3rV . **These brushes work with water soluble paint, too.

Panels/Canvas

Have some smaller canvases or panels available for exercises and studies. Canvas paper is an affordable option also. For larger paintings the size is up to you, but I would recommend having a range between 12x12 up to 16x20.

I use a variety of surfaces, but for workshops I recommend Centurion Universally Acrylic Primed Linen Panels (good affordable option) or Centurion Deluxe Professional Oil Primed

Linen Panels (a little pricier but another great option). I get mine at <https://www.jerrysartarama.com/>. **Make sure whatever you use is decent quality, and again, feel free to use what you have already.**

Additional Supplies

- **Sketchbook and sketching pencil.**
- **ValueComp** from Artwork Essentials <http://artworkessentials.com/products/valuecomp/index.htm>. I HIGHLY recommend getting one if you do not currently have one.
- **View Finder** from Artwork Essentials. I HIGHLY recommend getting one if you do not currently have a view finder.
