



## MATERIAL LIST

Start collecting empty cardboard boxes. We will work on 4.25 x 6 format but we will piece things together so don't worry if some of the boxes you collect are smaller than that or have folds or holes or flaws in them. I love flaws, they just add character to your piece.

- recycled cardboard: cereal boxes, crackers, tissu boxes, etc.
- 3 or 4 empty toilet paper rolls
- brayer (I like to use a 2"(5cm) wide, but you can use a larger one)
- acrylic paint: black and white plus 3 or 4 of your favorite colours (I use green, red, aqua and yellow)
- paper palette
- 4" (10 cm) paint roller handle
- awl
- embroidery thread and a needle
- round coffee filters
- buttons
- Rubber bands
- self stick foam sheets
- 1/8" hole punch
- collage papers
- glue stick, scissors and pencil
- wooden skewer
- washi tape
- exacto knife & cutting mat
- black drawing pen (I use Uni Pin pigment ink 0.6 or Marvy's "Le Pen" 0.5)
- uniball white signo pen (broad) or posca paint marker
- sewing machine (if you don't have one, you can always stitch by hand)
- flattened leaves (you can use an old book to store them)
- corner punch (optional)
- brads (optional)
