



MATERIALS

- Small Crock Pot (I use a half quart one)
- Beeswax pellets or chunks* (stakich.com or your local honey farm)
- 1” chip brush (pure bristle)
- 8x 10 or 10x10 panel board (you can also use canvas)
- Mini quilting iron with large iron tip adapter
- Heat gun or embossing tool
- White and colored tissue paper or rice paper
- Round coffee filters (optional)
- Black and white acrylic paint
- Stencils and stencil sponge or stippler
- White Uniball signo broad
- Black Unipin fine liner
- Collage papers, painted paper, napkins, sheet music, book pages, etc.
- Thread or string
- Optional: wax crayons, rubber stamps, leaves, buttons, found objects, etc

*If you have a hard time finding beeswax, you can always just use a beeswax candle, it's just more expensive than buying bulk beeswax.
