## Supply List

3 Gray toned markers, any brand, that are double ended with a small point and a wider end. I prefer Copic because they are refillable, greatly reducing your long term costs.

A permanent black felt tip pen with a fine point. I use the Sharpie Ultra Fine Point. Fine tipped Pitt pens are fine. There are many available that will work.

One sketch book made of card stock or a heavy weight paper with a smooth finish. I make my own and there will be instructions for how to do this inexpensively on my blog. [darrellanderson.blogspot.com](http://darrellanderson.blogspot.com)

A white ink ball point pen. Uniball Sign works well as it can go over the marker ink and cover the best.
