

Lisa Bebi - Supply List

Paint: I use acrylics, I am a GOLDEN Educator but any brand of acrylics work. If you are an oil painter, please buy a few colors of acrylics for the underpainting. I suggest: red, orange, ocher and brown or blue. The quality of the paint does not matter. Often I use craft paint such as CraftsMart or Apple Barrel.

Brushes: I am a SILVER Brush Lmt. Educator - for acrylics the best brushes are SILVER Silk 88's and/or Bristlon brushes. Discount brushes can be bought at www.thebrushguys.com . For an added discount use "Bebibrushes" in the discount code section at check out. You'll need at least one 1 1/2" brush. I use a variety of flat and round brushes.

Substrates: Choose a size that suits you. I will be working smaller because my work will be on camera. I demo throughout the workshop.

FOR OUR FIRST CLASS: PLEASE HAVE YOUR CANVAS OR BOARD PAINTED COMPLETELY IN A WARM COLOR, SUCH AS ORANGE! Also, have on hand a couple of cheap colored markers and index cards.
