Travel Sketching and Journaling - Materials:

Paper: Watercolor Journal. There are several to choose from:

- 1. Stillman & Born Nova, Delta or Zeta Mixed Media Sketchbook, 5.5" x 8.5"**
- 2. Moleskine A4 Watercolor Folio Album**
- 3. Holbein Multimedia Book**
- 4. Leuchtturm 1917 Sketchbook**

Brushes: Pointed rounds - either size 6 or 8. Or a set of travel brushes. There are several quality brands including: Rosemary & Co, Escoda, Tintoretto, Silver Black Velvet Voyage.

Travel watercolor Palette: An empty metal "Bijoux" box can be filled with half or full pans of your favorite colors. Empty pans can be found online (Amazon, Dick Blick, Jerry's ArtoRama)

Watercolors: Suggested colors, in pans to fit travel palette
You may have a well established color palette and we can use whatever you've got. If you are new to watercolor, the following will be a good fundamental start.
