

Material List for Wayne Jiang Online Painting Workshop Luminous Snow Paintings in Acrylic :

- Color palette or tray (do not use watercolor palette, cafeteria food tray is preferred)
- A roll of a parchment paper
- Brushes:

Assortment of brushes: Filbert: #12, #8

Small: Round # 2 #1

- A hair dryer
- Small bottle of gesso
- Wet/dry Sandpaper 220 grit (for sanding gessoed painting surfaces)
- #2 Pencils and rubber easers
- Black carbon paper (for tracing, can be purchased at office supply store like Staples or Office Depot)
- one 8"x8", and two 10"x10" square stretched canvases or gesso panels, (if you preferred you are welcome to paint bigger at 12"x12", 14"x14")
- Acrylic colors in a tube or jar:
 - Regular or soft body acrylic only,
 - No acrylic fluid, ink acrylic or open acrylic please.
 - Golden, Liquitex, Nova Colors are the preferred brands
(For beginners Liquitex heavy body is preferred, for more experienced artists Golden or Nova Color are the preferred brands)

Colors:

- Titanium White
 - Yellow Ochre
 - Burnt Sienna
 - Raw Umber Dark
 - Ultramarine Blue
 - Cadmium Yellow Medium
 - Cadmium Red Medium
 - Gloss Medium and vanish
- In smaller tubes:
- Permanent Green Light
 - Phthalocyanine Blue (green shade)
 - Dioxazine Purple
 - Alizarin Crimson
