### **ACRYLIC PAINTING SUPPLY LIST**

**Golden Open Acrylic Paint** – This brand stays wet longer and works better in plein air painting. Basic list below, if you have other colors that you like you may bring them.

- Cadmium Yellow Medium
- Yellow Ochre
- Alizarin Crimson Hue
- Naphthol Red Light
- Ultramarine Blue
- Teal Blue
- Transparent Red Iron Oxide
- Ivory Black
- Titanium White (large tube)

#### **Supplies**

Portable easel/setup for outdoor painting, doesn't need to be elaborate. U-go plein air box and easel is a good option for the price. I actually use a board while sitting with my paper palette on the top and my painting surface on the bottom.

Brushes: Please use what you like. I tend to like synthetic or hog bristle- A good variety of sizes (such as 2,4,8) flats and/or filberts, rounds ok if you like them. Princeton Aspen is a good choice for synthetic or Robert Simmons Signature for hog bristle.

Palette knife

Paper Palette is fine especially for travel

Several Surfaces on which to work, such as:

- Gessoed paper

- Water Color Paper

- Canvas Sheets

- Canvas Panels

Masking tape

Container to hold water

Pack Stool if you plan to sit

Small drawing pad and dark pencil or charcoal and camera

**Optional:** Sunscreen, bug spray, hat and/or visor, water bottle, food, windbreaker, warm jacket, disposable gloves
