Suggested Materials List – Watercolor

Watercolor Paper:

Recommended: Arches 20 sheet 7x11 (or 8x10) [140#](#) cold press [blocks](#). A second option is a similar size 140# cold press watercolor journal. A third option is a stack of 140# cold press watercolor paper, all the same size, with a slightly larger stiff board (and tape on which to adhere your paper to the board). Keep in mind: We will be creating paintings and studies over the course of 7 days. If you feel you may paint more studies or paint outside of class time, you may need more paper.

Brushes:

Sable or Synthetic Sable Watercolor Brush, #8 or #10 round or #2 quill. I use [Davinci Casaneo #2 Quill](#)
Inexpensive [flat #2](#) (for scrubbing)
Inexpensive round #6 for removing pigment
In addition to the above, bring any brush you like

Paint:

Watercolor paints in assorted colors (pans or tubes). Make sure you have a couple of reds, yellows, and blues. I have many colors, but my go-to pigments are the following, FYI (just use what you have):
Daniel Smith: Manganese Blue, Ultramarine Deep, Cobalt. Cobalt Teal Blue, Serpentine Green, Green-Gold, Quinacridone Coral, Opera, Vermillion, New Gamboge, Hansa Yellow, Nickel Azo Yellow, Quinacridone Burnt Orange, Indigo. Always evolving!

Palette:

Either manufacturer pre-filled cake, self-filled, hinged or lidded, with mixing area; there are many varieties. I use [Art Toolkit](#).

Easel: Bring what you normally use. Some artists may prefer easels or pochade boxes, others may choose to sit on walls and paint on their laps.

Drawing Supplies: Paper, Pencil, Eraser, Ruler, Marker:

Any paper on which to draw (I use a small notebook), any medium hardness pencil (like a #2), soft eraser, any small ruler, any non-water-soluble permanent marker or fountain pen (I use [Micron PN markers](#))

Water Container.

Water container. Small water sprayer. Sponge (any type) and a few blue paper towels.

Apron or old shirt to wear to protect your clothes from splatters
