

Janet's Recommended Supply List:

I will be painting/demo-ing in acrylic and gouache. My set-up works for both these mediums.

Light weight easel. I have a **plein air pro easel** that I use with a tray that holds my water container for brushes, as well as a 9x12" paper (disposable) palette and there's room for my container of paint. This easel is light and fits in my backpack. I can use for both acrylic and gouache painting.

If you paint in oil, a mix of warm/cool for your primaries, plus Titanium white.

Acrylic Paint: I suggest a limited palette (plus Titanium white) of Golden Heavy-Body Paint.

3-Color Limited Palette

phthalo blue, red shade #1260
C.P. cadmium yellow light #1120
quinacridone red #1310
Titanium White

6-Color Limited Palette

cobalt blue #1140
turquoise (phthalo) #1390
C.P. cadmium yellow light #1120
C.P. cadmium orange #1070 or pyrrole orange #1276
pyrrole red #1277
primary magenta #1510
Titanium White

Gouache: mix of warms and cools on the primaries. I like Utrecht and Windsor Newton.
cad yellow med/cad yellow light
cad red light or med/ aliz crimson or permanent rose
phthalo blue (green shade NOT red shade) / ultramarine blue or cobalt blue
titanium white

Plastic storage containers with lids to store paint. Instead of hauling all your paint tubes along on day of painting, this will organize your paint and you can refill this container. I use for both gouache and acrylic.

Brushes: I use Princeton brushes for oil and acrylics (a mixture of brights, filberts and angular brights) My largest brush is #12 Bright ,which is 1" wide to lay in the larger shapes and background, a #6 angular to carve out shapes.... and #3 to sketch the initial layout.

palette knife

palette paper (and clips to secure this pad to your easel)

Surfaces: Canvas panels, or canvas paper 9 x12", 8x10", 12 x 12".

Canson Plein Air Canva Pad is a great option. They are thin, light boards with a canvas surface. And light to travel.

little spray bottle to spritz or paint (if water based)

Small notebook for sketch/notes

viewfinder

clips (to secure pallet paper) and artists tape for single sheet paper set up.

rags (old t-shirts, washrags)

hat for sun

apron with pockets for phone, sketchbook, I hook my spray bottle in the pocket. Think of this as an extra space to store essentials like iPhone, plastic gloves, sunblock
