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Suggested Supply List

Watercolors:

There are many good sets of watercolors to use.

You can find several sets that are similar in size and quality such as Yarka, Windsor & Newton, Sennelier and Koi.

I like to use a palette that has empty and and buy tubes of paint and fill the pans with the tubed paint. I let it sit open for a day or two to let the paint set. Then, it's ready to use. I use Windsor & Newton, Sennelier, Daniel Smith & Holbein paints in tubes.
